

APPENDIX “A”– INFRACTIONS is hereby added to read as follows:

ENFORCEMENT

The Fire Chief of the District is designated as the Chief Fire Official of the District. The Fire Chief and his/her designated Fire Marshal shall have all the powers of peace officers in enforcing the California Fire Code; pursuant to Section 830.37 of the California Penal Code. The Fire Marshal may issue orders, notices, and citations and make arrests for violations within the South Placer Fire District; pursuant to Section 13870, 13871, 13872, 13872.5 and 13873 of the California Health and Safety Code.

113.4 Violation penalties. Persons who shall violate a provision of this code or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements thereof or who shall erect, install, alter, repair or do work in violation of the approved construction documents or directive of the fire code official, or of a permit or certificate used under the provisions of this code, shall be guilty of an infraction. Each infraction will be punishable by an administrative fine, in accordance with Government Code Section 36900 which states (b) Every violation determined to be an infraction is punishable by (1) a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100) for a first violation; (2) a fine of two hundred dollars (\$200) for a second violation of the same ordinance within one year; (3) a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) for each additional violation of the same ordinance within one year. (3) A fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) for each additional violation of the same ordinance within one year. (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a violation of local building and safety codes determined to be an infraction is punishable by the following:(1) A fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100) for a first violation. (2) A fine not exceeding seven five hundred dollars (\$500) for a second violation of the same ordinance within one year. (3) (A) A fine not exceeding one thousand three hundred dollars (\$1,000) for each additional violation of the same ordinance within one year of the first violation
