The South Placer Fire District is now accepting applications from both internal and external candidates for the position of Apprentice Firefighter. The District is developing a hiring list to fill anticipated positions that may be offered in the near future. The Apprentice Firefighter positions have been developed to assist interested candidates in acquiring firefighting experience that is needed for a career in the fire service. Positions are limited and applications must be submitted previous to 5:00 p.m. on December 18th, 2020.

- Qualified Candidates: must be a minimum of 18 years of age
- Must be a High School Graduate or Equivalent
- Must have a valid California Class C Driver's License with an Emergency Ambulance Endorsement
- Must have a valid Basic Life Support Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation Card from American Heart or Red Cross
- Must have a valid State of California Emergency Medical Technician I Certification or Sierra Sacramento Valley Paramedic Certification
- Must have a valid Hazardous Materials First Responder Operational Certificate
- Must have a valid Incident Command System ICS-200 Certificate
- Must have a valid California State Firefighter I Certificate or be a graduate from a Certified California Regional Firefighter I Academy.

The next phase of the process will be a CPS written examination. Candidates must receive a 70% minimum score to move forward in the process. Those passing the written test will be invited to participate in a structured oral interview panel. The Fire Chief will make the final selections from the list generated from the process. Candidates chosen for the positions will then go through a pre-employment background check.

Successful candidates will be placed on a eligibility list. Those appointed shall be paid \$15.00 per hour and limited benefits. Apprentice Firefighters will be assigned to work 24 hour shifts averaging 56 hours per week. The district currently works the 48/96 shift.
