The Position: The Deputy Chief is a member of the District's Management Team. Receiving general direction from the Fire Chief, the Deputy Chief is responsible for operational and personnel management, supervising Battalion Chiefs and maintenance personnel, and administering tasks related to fire suppression, hazardous condition mitigation, emergency rescue, medical treatment, and pre- and post-emergency activities. The Deputy Chief shall assume the role of Chief Executive Officer and, as such, provide highly responsible and technical support to the Board of Directors while exercising the highest degree of authority in the absence of the Fire Chief. The normal work schedule is Monday through Thursday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., with occasional night and weekend work required.

The Candidate Minimum Qualifications:

- The employee shall possess and maintain a valid Class C California Driver's License
- The employee shall possess a Certificate issued by the State of California as a Chief Officer (or an equivalent certificate from another state).
- A bachelor's degree from a Western Association of Schools and Colleges (or regional equivalent) or a National Fire Academy, Executive Fire Officer Graduate.
- Have a total of five (5) years of increasing responsibility in experience in emergency services operations, one (1) year of experience as a Battalion Chief or higher.

Desirable Qualifications

• Training or an educational degree from a recognized national, state, or privately operated training facility in the area of fire science, emergency services, or other related fields; for example, the National Fire Academy.
